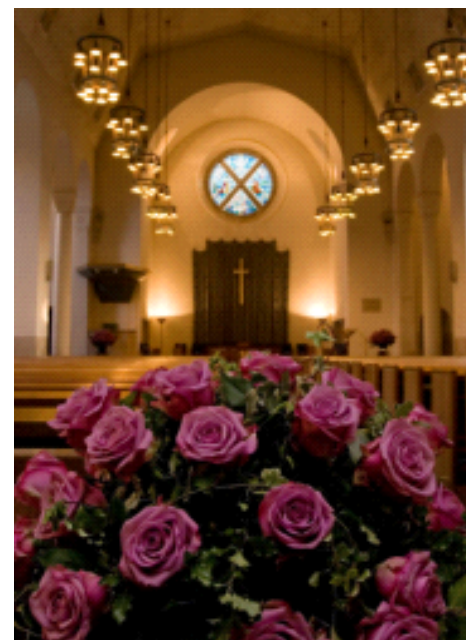

Marriage in St. Columba's Church



It is hoped that the following guidelines might be useful.

1. In Church we celebrate Christian Marriage. In form, the wedding can be large or small, elaborate or simple.
2. It is expected that the Minister or the Associate Minister of St. Columba's will officiate and be in sole charge of the service. The involvement of other ministers should be discussed well in advance.
3. The music must be arranged in consultation with the Director of Music, Mr David Terry. You should also discuss the involvement of soloists or pipers.
4. Please advise the Church Office of the day and time your florist wishes to do the flowers to arrange access. The positioning of flowers in the Church is at the discretion of the minister.
5. It is a strict legal requirement that notices of marriage should be given to the Registrar of Marriages in the registration districts in which both parties live.
[see local telephone directory under Registrar].
You cannot be married without the Certificate/License which they will issue.
6. In normal circumstances a rehearsal will be held in the Church 2 or 3 days before the wedding.
7. St. Columba's has ramp access, a lift to the Church level and toilet facilities for those who are disabled. The Church is fitted with an induction loop system for those who use hearing aids.

8. The printing of service sheets can be arranged through the Church in consultation with the minister.
9. There is no fee for members for the Minister or Associate Minister. However, you may consider giving a donation to the 'Ministers' Welfare Fund'. This is **not** for the ministers welfare but helps to purchase luncheon vouchers for distribution to the homeless who call at the church.

Photography

1. The video is made by a professional photographer or someone designated by those organizing the wedding.
2. The video must be taken from the gallery at the rear of the church and the person must not move from there.
3. No additional lighting will be used
